## Cory Kamehanaokala Holt Taum, b. 1990

Hānau Ka Pō – The Night Gave Birth Vinyl mural, 2022

Hōʻike aku kēia hakuhia lauana i ka huakaʻi o ke kanaka noʻeau ma ke ʻano he haumāna na ke Kumu Kākau Uhi, ʻo Suluʻape Keone Nunes. Hōʻike kā Cory hakuhia i ka wehena o ka wā mua o ke kumulipo, ka wā hoʻi e hānau mua ʻia nā mea mua o ke kai mai ka pō mai.

He 'elua kaukani a 'oi lālani o ke Kumulipo, a 'o ke mele ko'ihonua ho'i e hō'ike ana i ka loli 'ana o ke ola, ka hānau 'ia 'ana mai o ke kanaka, a me ka pilina o ke kanaka i kēlā me kēia mea o ke ao. He pilina ko ke kai me ko ka 'āina, a hō'ike 'ia ia 'ano pilina mao nā lālani mele o ke Kumulipo. Hō'ike pū 'ia ka mo'okū'auhau o nā ali'i mai kinohi a hiki mai i nā makahiki 1700.

Hoʻolauna: He kanaka noʻeau ʻōiwi ʻo Cory Kamehanaokalā Holt Taum e noho a hana ana ma Hawaiʻi. He kanaka haku kiʻi paia a he kanaka noʻeau i pā kāna mau hana a hakuhia i nā moʻolelo a me nā haʻawina o ke au i hala a pehea hoʻi e pili ai i ko kēia au, i loko nō o ka loli mau e ʻike ʻia nei ma Hawaiʻi. Puni ʻo Cory i nā lauana ikaika a ʻaʻā o ka poʻe Hawaiʻi kahiko. Kaulana ʻo ia i kāna mau kiʻi pena ma nā ʻano ʻili like ʻole, ʻo ke keleawe kūkae hao, ʻo ke kimeki uhi ʻia i ka limu, a ʻo ke kumu Albezia hoʻi. Koho ʻo ia i ia mau ʻili like ʻole i mea e pā ai ka mea nānā, i noʻonoʻo hoʻi i ka hoʻokiwikā ʻia ʻana o ka ʻāina a pehea nō hoʻi ka hopena o ke ola o ka ʻāina a me ka poʻe o Hawaiʻi. Nui kā Cory mau hana ma nā kiʻi paia nui o ke kaiāulu a ua komo pū hoʻi ʻo ia i mau nohona hana noʻeau a me nā hoʻolauleʻa kiʻi paia kauʻāina ma ka Pākīpika.

## Cory Kamehanaokala Holt Taum, b. 1990

Hānau Ka Pō – The Night Gave Birth Vinyl mural, 2022

This composition of patterns reflects the artist's journey as a haumana (apprentice) of Master Tattoo Practitioner, Sulu`ape Keone Nunes. Cory's composition captures the opening of the first Wā (division/era) of the Kumulipo (creation chant) where the first elements of the ocean are born from the darkness. Containing over 2,000 lines, the Kumulipo is the story of the evolution of life, the emergence of kānaka (humans) and the connection of kānaka to all elements of the universe. The Kumulipo describes how organisms living in the sea are linked to organisms living on land. It traces the genealogy of ruling Chiefs of the 1700's back to the beginning of time.

**Bio**: Cory Kamehanaokalā Holt Taum is a Kānaka 'Ōiwi artist that lives and works in Hawai'i. He is an active mural artist and cultural practitioner sourcing his inspiration from the stories and teachings of the past and their relevance in today's drastically changing Hawai'i. Cory is fascinated with the bold, and powerful visual forms and patterns developed by the original people of Hawai'i. He is best known for his iconic paintings on a wide range of surfaces from rusted metal, moss covered concrete, to an invasive Albezia tree. The surfaces he chooses as his canvas hope to encourage the viewer to question the current state of urbanization, and its effect on the health of the 'aina (land) and the people of Hawai'i. Cory has worked on numerous large scale community murals as well as participated in multiple artist-in-residences and international mural festivals throughout the pacific.
